Background

In the past, the 205 Group (owners) and Vancouver Oil Company, Inc. (operators) used the L&C Deli site as a service station. In 1987, they found gasoline product in a sanitary sewer line and in groundwater. In 1991, they confirmed that piping connected to the L&C Deli facility had leaked. The contaminants of concern included total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline and benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene and xylenes. Cleanup work at the site occurred in 1987, 1992, 2011, and 2012, and it is now complete.

Ecology held a comment period on the proposed removal of the site from the Hazardous Sites List. Two comments were received during the comment period, which were in support of the proposed action. The site was removed from the Hazardous Sites List in 2019.
