The Department of Ecology (Ecology) appreciates your decision to independently clean up the Larsons Dry Cleaner facility (Site). Our records indicate that you have not reported conducting any remedial actions at the Site for some time. This letter requests information on the status of your cleanup and your continued interest in the Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP).

Request for Information

Please submit the following information to Ecology within 30 days of the date of this letter:

1. **Reports.** Please provide any reports documenting Site cleanup.
2. **Plan and schedule for completing the cleanup.** Please provide a cleanup action plan providing sufficient information for Ecology to concur that it is likely that the Site will be cleaned up in a reasonable timeframe.
3. **Required electronic data.** Please ensure that all environmental Site data collected since August 1, 2005, are accepted into Ecology's Environmental Information Management (EIM) system database. Ecology's current data submittal requirements are provided in Toxic Cleanup [Program Policy 840](#).¹
