Dear Ms. Musa:

This letter provides notice an emergency remedial action is being performed at 17230 Aurora Avenue North, Shoreline, Washington (the "Property") in response to historic releases of petroleum-related compounds discovered in the course of a construction project. The releases appear to relate to a former Union 76 service station located at the Property.

The remedial actions undertaken to date are confined primarily to investigation of the nature and extent of the releases. The investigation is ongoing. Subsequent actions will be determined following the investigation. Subsequent actions may include excavation, removal, or treatment of the releases, or some portion of them.

This notice is provided pursuant to WAC 173-340-545(3). The emergency remedial action is being performed in accordance with the Model Toxics Control Act ("MTCA"), Chapter 70.105D RCW, and the cleanup regulations promulgated thereunder, Chapter 173-340 WAC.

Based on the information available at this time, we believe ConocoPhillips, the corporate successor to Union 76, is potentially liable under MTCA for all costs to investigate and cleanup the releases at the Property.
