On September 23, 2015 the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at the following site:



The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice expired on October 23, 2015. We have not received comments from you as of October 27, 2015. Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at the Superlon Plastics Co. Site. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that you are a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to the Superlon Plastics Site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility, Marv Coleman, will contact you with any new information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site – cleanup activities have begun and are well underway.
