G-Logics worked collaboratively with Ecology to revise language in the Technical Memorandum (originally dated October 15, 2018, which presents Ecology's review comments for the Draft Feasibility Study Pilot Test Workplan. Ecology issued their revised Technical Memorandum, presenting their final edits and comments on the Feasibility Study Pilot Test Work Plan, on January 31, 2019.

2 - Summary of Sampling and Testing

Monitoring or sampling efforts did not occur during January.

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3 – Summary of Deviations from the Approved Workplan

There are currently no deviations from the approved workplans for this reporting period.

4 – Summary of Contacts with Representatives from Local Community, Public Interest Groups, Press, and Federal, State, and Tribal Governments

At the request of Ecology, G-Logics contacted Mr. Russell Betteridge, NPDES Inspector for the City of Tukwila on January 17, 2019 to discuss the recent discovery of diesel light non-aqueous phase liquid (LNAPL) in a storm water catch basin near the Site. Based on data collected for the RI, and considering other possible sources (e.g., spills on the roadway), G-Logics and Mr. Betteridge agreed that it was premature to identify Boeing Field Chevron as the LNAPL source.
