Parker Paint is in the process of removing 11 underground storage tanks at its' factory. On Friday, January 31, 1992 test results from samples taken by Hart/Crowser established a contamination problem under one of the tanks.

The suspected contamination appeared under the S-62 (Texanol) tank and is being retested to establish exact levels of product in the soil. This $\underline{\mathsf{tank}}$ was tested for leaking in 1990 and found to be tight.

The entire excavation has been covered with plastic and further test results are due February 4, 1992 from Hart/Crowser. As results and progress are available I will continue to keep you updated.
