Dear Craig, your request to install ten (10) new groundwater monitoring wells in the Holden Mine Site has been approved, subject to the following provisions:

- a) Well drilling, installation, and development must be performed in accordance with all relevant and previously approved plans and procedures for this project, including but not limited to those that pertain to: personnel safety, fire prevention, noxious weeds, soil erosion control, protection of surface water bodies, staging areas, location for spoils, management and disposal of hazardous waste materials, and compliance with all Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARARs).
- b) Any significant field issues that are encountered or proposed deviations from this work plan must be communicated to the Forest Service RPM as soon as practicable. Any significant deviations must be authorized in writing by the RPM before proceeding.
- c) Within 60 calendar days of completion of the well drilling, Intalco shall submit a well drilling report, including a map of Well locations with precise coordinates and elevations and complete well reports and logs.
- d) Ensure that Water Well Reports for all wells get submitted to the State of Washington within 30 days as required under Chapter 173-160 WAC.
