Dear Mr. Pich:

Thank you for submitting the results of your independent remedial action for the Department of Ecology's (Ecology's) review. Ecology appreciates your initiative in pursuing this administrative option under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the following information regarding the Havenwood Care Center facility located at 1821 Grove Street in Marysville, Washington:

1. TLC/TPH Soil Testing and Remediation - 2 UST Sites (UST's removed 4/90), prepared by Nowicki and Associates, dated January 29, 1993;
2. Careage Havenwood Care Center Bioremediation Project, prepared by Nowicki and Associates, dated July 6, 1993;
3. Task schedule and timeline for the installation of groundwater monitoring wells and water testing; and
4. Marysville Care Center Groundwater Sampling, prepared by Nowicki & Associates, dated April 22, 1994.

Based upon the above listed information Ecology has determined that, at this time, the site does not pose a threat to human health or the environment.

Therefore, Ecology has determined that no further action is necessary at this site under the MTCA, Chapter 70.105D Revised Code of Washington (RCW). Please note that because your remedial actions were not conducted under a consent decree with Ecology, this letter is not a settlement by the state under Ch. 70.105D.040(4) RCW.

This determination is made only with respect to the release identified in the remedial action reports listed above. This no further action determination applies only to the area of the property at 1821 Grove Street, Marysville, affected by the

release identified in the report. It does not apply to any other release or potential release at the property, any other areas on the property, nor any other properties owned or operated by CAREAGE.

Ecology does not assume any liability for any release, threatened release or other conditions at the site, or for any actions taken or omitted by any person or his/her agents or employees with regard to the release, threatened release, or other conditions at the site.

Ecology will update its databases to reflect this "No Further Action" determination. Your site will not appear in future publications of the Confirmed and Suspected Contaminated Sites Report (previously known as the Affected Media and Contaminants Report) or in future Leaking Underground Storage Tank Lists.
