

WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Removal of 7 underground storage tanks (USTs) and up to 1,300 cubic yards of contaminated soil from the site known as Harrison Texaco located at 905 Simpson Avenue, Hoquiam, WA, Grays Harbor County. The UST removal and associated cleanup is being conducted through a grant under the Washington Department of Ecology's Clean Sites Initiative.

Proponent: WA State Department of Ecology

Lead agency: WA State Department of Ecology
