Thank you for submitting the results of your independent remedial actions for review by the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology). Ecology appreciates your initiative in pursuing this administrative option under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the following information regarding the Highland Plaza – Former Nelson Chevron Service Station facility located at 1140 North 175th Street, Shoreline:

- UST Removal and Closure Documentation Report Roland D Nelson – Nelson Chevron 1140 North 175th Street Seattle, Washington Roy F. Weston, Inc., dated August 10, 2000
- 2. Phase I Environmental Site Assessment 1110, 1140, & 1144 North 175th Street Shoreline, Washington Kleinfelder, Inc., dated May 24, 2002
- 3. Limited Phase II Assessment Summary Highland Plaza NE 175th Street Shoreline, WA Hart Crowser, dated October 24, 2002

- Limited Phase II Investigation and Independent Remedial Action Highland Plaza Property 1140 North 175th Street Shoreline, Washington Kane Environmental, Inc., dated November 4, 2003
- Excavation & Removal of Petroleum-Contaminated Soil Highland Plaza – Former Nelson Chevron Service Station 1140 North 175th Street Shoreline, Washington Kane Environmental, Inc., dated June 7, 2004

The reports listed above will be kept in the Central Files of the Northwest Regional Office (NWRO) of Ecology for review by appointment only. Appointments can be made by calling Sally Perkins at the NWRO at (425) 649-7190 or -7239.

Based upon the information in the reports listed above, Ecology has determined that, at this time, the release of petroleum hydrocarbon as gasoline and heavy oil into the soil no longer poses a threat to human health or the environment.

Therefore, Ecology is issuing this determination that no further remedial action is necessary at this site under MTCA, chapter 70.105D RCW. However, please note that because your actions were not conducted under a consent decree with Ecology, this letter is written pursuant to RCW 70.105D.030(1)(i) and does not constitute a settlement by the state under RCW 70.105D.040(4) and is not binding on Ecology.

Ecology's no further action determination is made only with respect to the release identified in the reports listed above. This no further action determination applies only to the area of the property affected by the release identified in the reports at 1140 North 176th Street, Shoreline. It does not apply to any other release or potential release at the property, any other areas on the property, nor any other properties owned or operated by Highland Enterprises, LLC/AKC Auto Repair.

Ecology will update its Leaking Underground Storage Tank database to reflect this "No Further Action" determination. Your site will not appear in future publications of the LUST database. The state, Ecology, and its officers and employees are immune from all liability and no cause of action of any nature that may arise from any act or omission in providing this determination.
