This letter is to provide a project status in response to a letter from Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) dated May 13, 2019. The current status is that the site investigation is not complete and the City needs to submit a supplemental work plan to Ecology. The City has not identified a timeline for resuming work and submitting a supplemental work plan and, in a separate letter to Ecology, withdrew from the VCP program for this site.

The last correspondence was from myself, dated May 23, 2017, stating we will prepare an agenda and figures for a meeting with Ecology. The City never provided that info and there was no further communication between the City and Ecology regarding this project until May of 2019. Between 2017 and 2019, the City did one boring on the site to investigate the soil conditions for the installation of a tide gate. We have unfortunately not uploaded that data into the EIM system but will have that uploaded by July 2019. This will ensure all the site information is in the EIM system.
