Dear Hatem Shalabi:

In accordance with correspondence dated December 21, 2017, and July 12, 2018,¹ the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) required you to provide reports regarding your cleanup being conducted under Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) project SW1333. These documents were required under a long term compliance monitoring plan associated with an environmental covenant (EC) recorded on Pierce County tax parcel 4715010367 (Property). A Property-Specific No Further Action (NFA) with the EC was issued for SW1333 on March 7, 2016.

On February 7, 2019, Ecology received EcoCon, Inc's (ECI's) groundwater monitoring reports dated from 2014-2016.

Based on the documents submitted, the Site's cleanup status will remain unchanged at this time. According to Ecology's records, the SW1333 Property-Specific NFA is due for a periodic review² in December 2020, during which the effectiveness of the implemented cleanup remedy will be evaluated. To continue to maintain the no further action status for the Property associated with the Site, all groundwater monitoring and cap inspection events must be conducted as required by the no further action letter and EC. If reporting is not completed as required in the EC, Ecology will rescind the Property-Specific NFA.

To avoid having the Property-Specific NFA rescinded at the time of the periodic review:

- 1) Ensure that all reports required under the EC have been submitted.
 - a. The November 2017 groundwater monitoring event report is overdue. Submit this report immediately.
 - b. Submit a report for the May 2019 groundwater monitoring event.
 - c. Submit all remaining reports documenting agreed-to cap monitoring.
- 2) Site data collected since August 1, 2005, must be uploaded to Ecology's Environmental Information Management (EIM) system, per Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-340-840(5) and Ecology Policy 840.³ Ensure all applicable Site data have been uploaded by close of business on December 17, 2020. Upload of Site data into EIM can take weeks or months, so please plan accordingly.


