RE: Notice of Potential Liability Status

Dear Mr. Proctor:

Thirty calendar days have elapsed since Weyerhaeuser received notice that Ecology proposed to find it a "potentially liable person" under Section 4 of the Model Toxics Control Act for the Old Machine Shop, Everett Mill E Site. Weyerhaeuser has not objected to Ecology's proposed finding and no substantive information has been brought to Ecology's attention to date that would affect Ecology's proposed finding.

Therefore, notice is hereby given to Weyerhaeuser that Ecology finds Weyerhaeuser to be a "potentially liable person" under Section 4 of the Model Toxics Control Act, as applied to the "facility" known as Old Machine Shop, Everett Mill E Site located at 101 East Marine View Drive, Everett, Washington.

In response to your letter dated September 5, 1989, The Beazer Group has been sent a Proposed Finding of Potential Liability Status notice.
