Thank you for submitting the results of your independent remedial action(s) for review by the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology). Ecology appreciates your initiative in pursuing this administrative option under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the following information regarding the KRS Maine, 1621 S. 92nd Place, Seattle WA 98108:

1. Summary Report, Oil Contaminated Soil Cleanup Project, KRS Marine Facility, 1621 S. 92nd Place, Seattle WA 98108 by James P. Hurley Company, project # 000102 of April 25, 2000.

The above listed report will be kept in the Central Files of the Northwest Regional Office (NWRO) of Ecology for review by appointment only. Appointments can be made by calling Sally Perkins at the NWRO at (425) 649-7190.

Based upon the above listed information Ecology has determined that, at this time, the release of Petroleum hydrocarbon into the soil no longer poses a threat to human health or the environment.

Therefore, Ecology is issuing this determination that no further remedial action is necessary at this site under MTCA, chapter 70.105D RCW. However, please note that because your actions were not conducted under a consent decree with Ecology, this letter is not a settlement by the state under RCW 70.105D.040(4) and is not binding on Ecology.


