Dear Mike:

As per our conversation regarding the rates and charges for placing bundles of logs into the water for rafting, the following will apply:

The Port agrees to a wharfage and service and facilities charge of \$0.16 per ton.

The Port will allow Ten (10) days free time exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and legal Holidays after the first 7 a.m. occurring after the cargo has been placed on wharf premises for movement to the water.


Assembling time up to 20 days exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays beyond the regular free time allowance will be granted for assembling 200 tons or more of cargo for a particular shipment.

These conditions will be for a period of 180 days and are subject to change by the Port of Anacortes according to the Port's Marine Terminal Tariff No. 9.

This agreement is cancelable by written notice from either party with 30 day notification.
