

# FIRST AMENDMENT TO OPERATING AGREEMENT BETWEEN PORT OF ANACORTES AND FRONTIER INDUSTRIES, INC.

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO OPERATING AGREEMENT between PORT OF ANACORTES AND FRONTIER INDUSTRIES, INC., made the day of felo, 1987, by and between the Port of Anacortes, a Washington municipal corporation hereinafter referred to as "the Port", and Frontier Industries, Inc. a Washington corporation, hereinafter referred to as "F.I." amends original Agreement dated August 21, 1986.

WHEREAS, the Port contracted with F.I. to perform certain work pursuant to the terms and conditions of the original Agreement dated August 21, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend certain terms and conditions of their original Agreement dated August 21, 1986;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and conditions in the original Agreement and in this First Amendment to said original Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

### (1) TERM

The term of the Agreement as amended herein shall be from January 1, 1987 to December 31, 1987. Either party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement during the term hereof on one hundred twenty (120) days written notice to the other party or upon any breach of the provisions of the Agreement as herein amended.

### (2) <u>COMPENSATION</u>

The Port shall pay F.I. the rate of eight (8) dollars per 1000 board feet for the "basic operation" referred to in Paragraph 1 of the original Agreement. Gross scale will apply and log volume processed shall be determined by scaling bureau summary sheets. This rate shall apply to export and domestic logs with loads or bundles having ten (10) sorts or less. Rates compensating F.I. for services other than the "basic operation" at ten (10) sorts or less are shown on Exhibit "A" and shall be in effect for the term of this Agreement as amended.

(3) All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement, except as herein specifically amended, shall remain the same.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Agreement on the day and year first written above.
