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Gentlemen:


In an effort to improve our log storage and handling capabilities, we are planning to pave a portion of our Pier II log storage yard in September. Attachment 1 shows the area to be paved and Attachment 2 is the project schedule. Our main concern about the schedule is the construction period. Of course, our aim is to pave when such would least interfere with our log yard operations such as a fire season or some other slow period. Paving, however, must be done before the asphalt plants close due to cold weather.

We would be most grateful if you would review our project schedule and give us your best estimates on when we could clear the log yard area identified. Because we would like to make at least a tentative decision on scheduling of this project prior to June 9, we would appreciate a reply from you prior to this date.
