# Re: Termination of various VCP Projects from the former Shell Multi Site Agreement—AECOM Sites

Dear John Robbins:

We received AECOM's letters on your behalf responding to our request for information on the status of the 28 Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) sites that were formerly enrolled in the Shell Multi Site Agreement (MSA). Of the 28 sites on the list, seven sites were managed by a different consultant and discussed under separate cover. The remaining 21 sites are the focus of this letter. Of the 21 sites managed by AECOM:

- We did not received any response for four sites.
- We received response from Renee Knecht for 11 sites.
- We received response from Mike Edwards for three sites.
- We received response from Demetrio Cabanillas for three sites.

The responses provided by AECOM personnel on your behalf did not provide a the detailed Cleanup Project Status or Work Plan and a detailed cleanup schedule we asked for in our March 2019 letter. Based on these responses, we have decided to terminate all 21 AECOM-managed sites. These sites are:

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) is terminating the VCP Agreement governing Project No. **NW2079**. The project involved the cleanup of the Minit Lube 1110 facility (Site). The effective date of termination is the date of this letter. We are providing this notice in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

#### Reason

Ecology is terminating the Agreement because you have not asked for any opinion from us since October 16, 2013. A Status Request letter was sent to you with copy to your consultant on March 29, 2019. Ecology received your response for this specific Site on May 3, 2019.

To be in VCP, Ecology requires that VCP sites are actively conducting remedial actions and requesting an opinion on current or planned work. In your response letter, you indicated that the property owner is on the planning stages for redevelopment. However, a timeframe for the redevelopment was not provided. Ecology also requires that a schedule of planned cleanup milestones is submitted for sites in the VCP. Since a schedule for cleanup of the Site and a timeframe for submittal of a cleanup report and a request for opinion was not submitted, Ecology is not able to keep this site in the VCP at this time.

If you decide to request an opinion on your cleanup efforts or wish to ask for assistance for this Site, you can apply to the Pollution Liability Insurance Agency (PLIA) Petroleum Technical Assistance Program (PTAP) when more remedial activities have occurred or a request for opinion is needed.

1. Conduct a site hazard assessment (SHA) and rank the Site for further action.
