This letter presents AECOM's response on behalf of Equilon Enterprises LLC (d/b/a/ Shell Oil Products US [Shell]) to Ecology's *Request for Information on State of VCP Project for the following Site: Site Name: Shell 120877, Site Address: 210 NE 45th Street, Seattle, Washington 98105 (Property). The purpose of the letter is to provide answers to the Request for Information, below.*

Subsequent to the mentioned March 31, 2010 issuance of an opinion, two subsurface investigations were completed, in 2014 and 2015, and submitted to Ecology. These investigations included advancement of several soil borings and installation of a groundwater monitoring well, in order to further delineate known impacts. Additionally, periodic groundwater monitoring has been conducted by AECOM and others since that time, most recently submitted in May, 2018. Specifically, MW-9 has been observed to be dry since installation in 2014 through 2015, and occasionally thereafter; this is the most down-gradient well and monitoring will continue as part of ongoing characterization.
