



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal:

The proposal includes interim actions to be conducted under MTCA Agreed Order No. 2692 , as amended. These actions include:

- Excavation and off-site disposal of contaminated soils;
- Capping contaminated soils in place;
- Installation and operation of one free product recovery well and reactivation of existing recovery wells ;
- Treatability/pilot study on the treatment of PCBs in groundwater.

The Site is Kaiser's 512-acre facility located at 15000 E. Euclid Ave. in the City of Spokane Valley, WA .

Lead Agency:

Washington State Department of Ecology
