Thank you for forwarding via email the proposal for installation of a septic drain field (Enclosure A) to support the planned future building. The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed septic drain field proposal and does not have any objections provided that the requirements listed in Ecology's August 6, 2019, letter¹ are followed (for example: notifications, soil management, and access).

The request to construct the building was previously approved by Ecology in the August 6, 2018, letter. However, at the time of the August 2019 approval, Ecology was not provided with any information regarding septic drain field installation and so the approval letter did not include this.

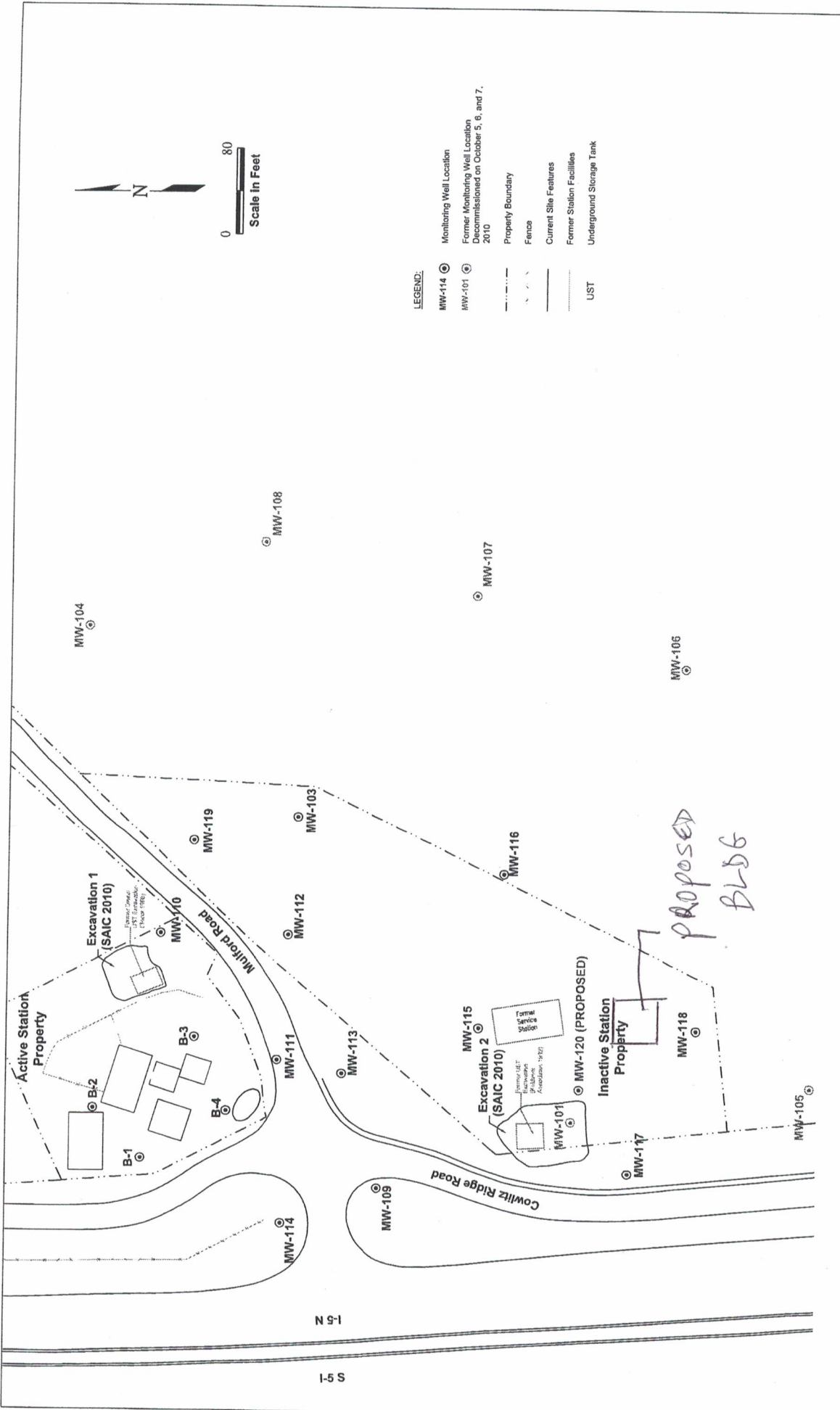
