This provides EPA notifications as required by Paragraphs 25, 26, and 53 of the Unilateral Administrative Order for Remedial Design and Remedial Action.

Notification of Supervising Contractor (Paragraph 25)

The Supervising Contractor for the remedial design will be Tetra Tech, Inc from Bothell, Washington. Gary Braun will serve as the Supervising Contractor's project manager. Tetra Tech has a quality assurance system that is compliant with ANSI/ASQ E4-2004, as required by the Order, and is familiar with the Site because they performed the Site Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study. As required by Unilateral Administrative Order paragraph 38, The Supervising Contractor's quality assurance requirements will be detailed in the Quality Assurance Project Plan that is required to be delivered prior to the commencement of sampling and monitoring. Lockheed Martin will provide advance notification and request EPA approval for any change in the Supervising Contractor.

Notification of Lockheed Martin's Project Coordinator (Paragraph 26)

Lockheed Martin's Project Coordinator will be Bill Bath, as previously noted in Mary Morningstar's April 12, 2015 Notice of Intent to Comply. Gene Matsushita will serve as Lockheed Martin's Alternate Project Coordinator. Bill Bath's shipping and e-mail addresses are:

Bill served as Lockheed Martin's Project Coordinator for the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study for the site and has over 30 years of experience in environmental

remediation. Lockheed Martin will provide advance notification and request EPA approval for any change in Project Coordinator.

For purposes of Order paragraph 59, other individuals who are authorized to submit documents on behalf of Lockheed Martin are Gene Matsushita and myself.

Certification regarding Records Destruction (Paragraph 53)

Lockheed Martin hereby certifies, to the best of its knowledge and belief, that it has not altered, mutilated, discarded, destroyed, or otherwise disposed of any records (other than identical copies) relating to its potential liability regarding the Site since notification of its potential liability and that it has fully complied with any and all EPA requests for information regarding the Site.

Please issue authorization to proceed based on our notification of the proposed Supervising Contractor. As specified in the Unilateral Administrative Order, the deadline for Lockheed Martin submission of the Remedial Design Work Plan is triggered by EPA's authorization to proceed. We look forward to working with EPA on the Lockheed West Seattle project.
