## **Ecology Wants Your Input**

Ecology invites your comments on proposed plans to clean up the Bay Wood Products Site (Site). This is one of several properties on the Everett waterfront identified for cleanup under the state's Puget Sound Initiative. The Site is generally located at 200 West Marine View Drive in Everett, WA. Ecology is working in partnership with the Port of Everett (Port) to achieve cleanup at the Site.

- Review the draft Second Amendment to the Agreed Order.
- Send your comments on the draft Second Amendment to the Agreed Order to Ecology for consideration. Comments accepted from December 16, 2019 January 17, 2020.
- Ecology will consider all comments before making a final decision.

## Site Background

The Site is located on fill material placed in Port Gardner Bay. Lumber and mill operations began on this Site around 1936. In 1979, Bay Wood Products, Inc. removed the sawmill and used the Site for log handling and storage until 1994. The Site currently remains vacant. Prior cleanup actions conducted at the Site included: 1) removal of soil contaminated by polychlorinated biphenyls in 1985 and 1993, 2) removal of wood waste in 1995, and 3) removal of soil and dredge material containing carcinogenic polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons in 2013, which was request by the first Agreed Order Amendment.

## Second Amendment to the Agreed Order

The Department of Ecology, with the Port, has developed a second amendment to the Agreed Order to expedite cleanup, and habitat restoration at the Site's shoreline, and surrounding areas.
