Dear Patty, Joe, and R.J.:

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) is responding to the second deadline extension request for the Supplemental Remedial Investigation Work Plan (SRIWP). This letter provides approval for the second deadline extension. **However, this is the last submittal extension request Ecology will allow for the SRIWP.**

The SRIWP submittal deadline set in Agreed Order DE 15806 is 90 days from the effective date of the Agreed Order. The Agreed Order effective date was May 20, 2019, making the deadline date for receipt of the draft SRIWP August 19, 2019. On August 30, 2019, Ecology provided approval to the August 14, 2019, request for submittal deadline extension.

The first extension submitted in August 2019 requested the due date for the draft SRIWP to be 60 days following receipt of Ecology's alignment on the SRIWP technical approach. Ecology received the technical approach at the October 2, 2019, joint meeting. A memorandum dated October 8, 2019, from Ecology indicated alignment with the technical approach, which placed the due date for the draft SRIWP to be December 9, 2019.

This second extension approval extends the due date for the draft SRIWP to February 14, 2020.
