



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The Department of Ecology proposes to excavate waste generated from a secondary aluminum smelting process. This waste was deposited on industrial park property owned by the Port of Klickitat near Dallesport, Washington. This waste will be hauled by rail and/or truck to an appropriate landfill.

Proponents: Washington State Department of Ecology

Location of proposal, including street address if any: Recycled Aluminum Metals Company (RAMCO) Disposal Site, within Section 25 Township 2 North Range 13 East, W.M., approximately two miles east of Dallesport, Washington.

Lead agency: Washington State Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
