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Dale,

I believe that you have already discussed this with James Kiernan of CEMC. However, I am also following up with this email in order to provide some additional details and to keep all of the stakeholders informed on our currently anticipated path forward for this site.

As you may already know, a site access agreement was executed in mid-December for the property located at 1932 5th Street and CEMC is still working to negotiate terms for an agreement for the property at 1936 5th Street. We have also received approval from the City of Bremerton for the planned work in the Naval Avenue right-of-way and in the alley to the south of the service station property.

At this time, our plan is to move forward with coordination of the work that our current permit and access agreements will allow us to complete. We currently anticipate beginning this phase of field work on or about January 27th. The first phase of work would include completion of soil sampling and installation of the soil vapor sampling probes, and soil vapor sampling would likely occur the following week. If the access agreement for the 1936 5th Street property is executed before that time, the proposed work on that property would also be completed as part of that mobilization. Otherwise, a future additional mobilization will be necessary.

The current deadline for completion of the RI field activities is February 26, 2020. However, based on our currently anticipated schedule, it may be necessary to request another extension to the schedule. The extension may be necessary for the following reasons:

1. At this time it is unclear whether access to the 1936 5th Street property will be obtained in time to complete the proposed work on this property prior to the current deadline.
2. Laboratory results for soil and/or soil vapor samples collected in late January or early February may not be received and/or thoroughly evaluated prior to the current deadline. Evaluation of these data are necessary to determine whether the RI field activities are complete.

I will follow-up with you when we have a better understanding of our need, and the associated timing, for another schedule extension.

With regard to the meeting proposed below, we suggest that the meeting be delayed until late February or early March in order to allow review and discussion of data collected during the next round of RI field activities.

Please let me know if you have any questions regarding our anticipated path forward.
