RE: Determination of Potentially Liable Person Status

Dear Mr. Sharfstein:

On April 5, 2012, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent the Kimberly-Clark Corporation (K-C) written notice regarding its proposed status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at the following site:

On April 30, 2012, Ecology received a letter from you indicating that K-C has chosen to accept its status as a PLP for the Kimberly-Clark Worldwide Site, which includes both upland and adjacent in-water (associated with the East Waterway) areas where hazardous substances have been deposited, stored, disposed of, placed, or otherwise come to be located. Ecology finds that credible evidence exists that supports K-C's status as a PLP for release at the Kimberly-Clark Worldwide Site. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that K-C is a PLP with regard to the Kimberly-Clark Worldwide Site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility, Andy Kallus, will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
