



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
(DNS)

Description of Proposal:

The proposal is Ecology's selected cleanup action for the Heglur Kronquist Site that is undergoing cleanup under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA). A multi-layer cap (consisting of a geosynthetic liner system, a drainage layer, and a top soil cover with vegetation) would be installed over the existing cap in order to reduce infiltration and promote better drainage. This landfill area is almost 4 acres in size. Future cap inspections and maintenance, institutional controls, and groundwater monitoring are additional components of this proposal,

Proponent:

Washington State Department of Ecology

Location of Proposal:

The Heglur Kronquist Site is located in a rural area near Mead, Washington, and near the intersection of E. Heglur and E. Kronquist Roads approximately 10 miles northeast of downtown Spokane, Washington.

Lead Agency:

Washington State Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c).
