Reporting Requirements

Please comply with the following reporting requirements, when requesting written opinions on planned or completed remedial actions:

- **Licensing.** You must submit documents containing geologic and hydrogeologic work conducted under the seal of an appropriately licensed professional, as required by Chapter 18.220 RCW ², and engineering work conducted under the seal of an appropriately licensed professional, as required by Chapter 18.43 RCW ³.
- **Data Submittal.** You must submit environmental sampling data in both a printed and electronic forms capable of being transferred into our Environmental Information Management system. For an overview of data submittal requirements, please refer to Enclosure 2, which includes a copy of the Toxics Cleanup Program Policy 840. For instructions on how to submit data, visit the EIM Submit Data web page ⁴.

Failure to comply with these requirements may result in unnecessary delays.

Payment

Ecology will send monthly invoices to the billing contact designated in the VCP Application form. If someone replaces the billing contact, or their contact information changes, please submit a Change of Contact form ⁵.

Our invoice will include a summary of the costs incurred, payments received, identity of staff involved, and the amount of time spent on the Project during the previous month. Payment is due within thirty days of the invoice date. For more information on the billing system, please refer to the VCP web page ⁶.
