

Washington's Formal Cleanup Process









Notable MTCA Events to Date



1992

- Underground storage tanks decommissioned
- 1,800 cubic yards of contaminated soil removed

2007

- Testing found light non-aqueous phase liquid (LNAPL or petroleum products that float on top of groundwater)
- Approx. 1,500 gallons of contaminated groundwater were removed by vacuum truck

2008

- Soil vapor investigation found soil vapor levels were below MTCA levels of concern


2009

- Approx. 560 gallons of contaminated groundwater were removed

2013-2014

- Routine groundwater monitoring found that contaminated groundwater beneath the Site remains above MTCA cleanup levels

Next Steps




Estimated Timeline

- **2020:** Respond to comments, finalize documents, and begin Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS)
- **2020 & beyond →** Public review and comment on RI/FS



