Thank you for working with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on Agri-Tech Yakima Steel Fabricators (Site). This letter provides written notification that the Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, and draft Cleanup Action Plan required at the Site by Agreed Order No. DE 6091 (Order) under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70.105D RCW, have been satisfactorily completed. The Order became effective on October 27, 2008 and was amended on October 17, 2016. This letter also describes the next steps for the Site.

Completion of Remedial Actions Required by the Order

Ecology has determined the requirements of the Order have been satisfied. Ecology made this determination pursuant to Section IX (Satisfaction of Order).

The remedial actions required by the Order are specified in Section VII (Work to Be Performed). Yakima Steel Fabricators, Inc. was required to provide a Feasibility Study and draft Cleanup Action Plan. After inspecting the Site and reviewing the supporting documentation, Ecology has determined the remedial actions in Section VII have been satisfactorily completed.

Next Steps at the Site

A Draft Cleanup Action Plan (DCAP) for the Site has been completed. After review and consideration of comments received during the public comment period, Ecology will issue a final Cleanup Action Plan (CAP).
