Dear Jake Lund:

Thank you for submitting your proposed Agreed Order schedule amendment<sup>1</sup> to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) for our review in accordance with Agreed Order Section VIII.L (Amendment of Order). Ecology agrees with your schedule with the exception of the proposed due date for submittal of data into Ecology's Environmental Information Management (EIM) database. Instead of submitting the data into EIM concurrent with the submittal of the Final Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Report, the EIM data submittal deadline shall be concurrent with the submittal of the Draft Final RI/FS Report (within 60 days after finalizing field work). The date of "finalizing field work" consists of the last day that samples are collected for analysis.

Therefore, the new schedule of deliverables is shown below, ***changes from the previous Agreed Order schedule<sup>2</sup> are highlighted in bold italic.*** This schedule change amendment is not considered a substantial change that requires public notice and opportunity to comment.

Deliverable	Schedule
<b><i>Response to Ecology's comments on the 2015 Draft RI/FS Report</i></b>	<b><i>October 1, 2020. If Ecology has comments on the response then a revised response document shall be provided within 30 days of Ecology's written comments.</i></b>
<b><i>Work Plan for Field Work</i></b>	<b><i>60 days after Ecology's written approval on the response-to-comments is received. Revised plan shall be submitted within 30 days of Ecology's written comments.</i></b>
<b><i>Field Work (Sampling and Analysis)</i></b>	<b><i>Complete within 6 months of receipt of Ecology's approval on the Work Plan</i></b>
Draft Final RI/FS Report	<b><i>Within 60 days after finalizing field work</i></b>
<b><i>Load all data into Ecology's EIM database.</i></b>	<b><i>Within 60 days after finalizing field work</i></b>
Final RI/FS Report	<b><i>45 days after Ecology's written comments on the Draft Final RI/FS Report are received, subsequent to public comment.</i></b>
Draft CAP	<b><i>45 days after the Final RI/FS Report is approved by Ecology, prior to public comment.</i></b>
