The PLPs met on Tuesday 2/25 and agreed that based on the RIWP results, remedial investigation (RI) data gaps exist at the Site that would prevent completion of the RI Report. The acknowledged RI data gaps are, but are not limited to, extent of groundwater exceedances, nature of soil gas screening level exceedances, and refining the extent of soil exceedances. Therefore, with respect to the requirements of the AO, the PLPs propose to Ecology a path forward of a RIWP Addendum to address these RI data gaps, in lieu of submitting the RI Report.

We request Ecology's comment and approval on this proposed path forward relative to the requirements of the AO. If a technical meeting is necessary to discuss this proposal, please let us know and we can coordinate. Thanks,
