



## REVISED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** Ecology plans to oversee a cleanup action at the Big B Mini Mart Site (Site) at 1611 Canyon Road in Ellensburg. This cleanup action will eliminate or reduce the actual or potential environmental exposure risk posed by diesel and gasoline contaminants in the soil and groundwater at the Site.

This is a revision of a prior SEPA review and determination issued in 2019 for the same property. The actions proposed are identical to the actions taken previously; however, various aspects are different such as the timing of the action, the quantities of soil, and the size of the land treatment area. The total volume of soil is 760 cubic yards that will be excavated and treated.
