## Dear Timothy L. Bishop:

Thank you for submitting your proposed 60-day extension request<sup>1</sup> for the submittal of the revised Feasibility Study (FS) Report to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) for our review in accordance with Agreed Order Section VII.K (Extension of Schedule). Your request letter also stated that CEMC and Arcadis plan to incorporate "many" of Ecology's requested edits.<sup>2</sup> Ecology wishes to limit the iterations of documents. Therefore, please contact Ecology as soon as possible, and before the new FS submittal deadline, if there are comments that CEMC and Arcadis are proposing to not incorporate so that this can be discussed and agreed upon before the submittal.

Therefore, Ecology agrees with your request for extension provided that every effort is made to reach agreement regarding how Ecology's comments are incorporated prior to the submittal of the revised FS. **The new deadline for the FS submittal is November 16, 2020**.
