Leidos, Inc. (Leidos), has prepared this Quarterly Progress Report (QPR) on behalf of Resource Environmental, LLC (RELLC), an environmental service provider to Chevron Environmental Management and Real Estate Company (Chevron). This QPR documents activities performed to satisfy the requirements of Agreed Order No. DE 10629, which was entered into by Chevron and the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) in June 2014 for the above-referenced site (the Site). This QPR covers the reporting period between July 1 and September 30, 2020.

ACTIVITIES COMPLETED DURING THE CURRENT REPORTING PERIOD:

- In July 2020, Chevron transitioned management and direction of future work required under Agreed Order No. DE 10629 to RELLC. RELLC has contracted Leidos to resume their previous role as the primary environmental consultant for the project.
- In July 2020, RELLC initiated requests to obtain property access agreements to conduct future supplemental remedial investigation activities on the properties at 221 E. Woodin Avenue and 136 E. Johnson Avenue. To date, RELLC has fully executed an agreement for the property at 221 E. Woodin Avenue; however, access negotiations for the property at 136 E. Johnson Avenue are still on-going.
- On August 6, 2020, representatives of Chevron, RELLC, Leidos, and Arcadis met with Ecology through a web-based virtual meeting to discuss the transition of the management and consultant roles for the project.

- On August 27, 2020, representatives of RELLC and Leidos met with Ecology through a web-based virtual meeting to discuss proposed modifications to the Supplemental Remedial Investigation Work Plan Phase 5, which had previously been prepared by Arcadis and which was approved by Ecology on June 24, 2020.
- On September 23, 2020, Leidos submitted an agency review draft copy of Addendum 1 to the Supplemental Remedial Investigation Work Plan Phase 5. This document was approved by Ecology with minor revisions and a final copy was issued on September 24, 2020.
- Leidos began planning and coordination of the SRI Phase 5 field activities.

ACTIVITIES ANTICIPATED FOR THE NEXT REPORTING PERIOD:

- Leidos will begin SRI Phase 5 field activities at the Site in late-October or early-November 2020.
- A groundwater monitoring and sampling event is expected to be completed in November or December 2020.
