Enclosed is a copy of the Interim Action Report, prepared by our staff, which provides details of the cleanup conducted last summer. The Department of Ecology (Ecology) appreciated the opportunity to partner with you in keeping children safe. The lead and arsenic contaminated soil from prior pesticide use has been removed or reduced, and as such, no further action is required (under the Model Toxics Control Act, chapter 70.105D RCW) to protect human health and the environment.

Ecology will update its database to reflect this "No Further Action" determination. The school will not appear in future publications of the Confirmed & Suspected Contaminated Sites Report. Ecology will also initiate the process to remove the school from the Hazardous Sites List. This process does include a thirty (30) day public comment period.
