## Drum removal begins in October

The Washington Department of Ecology is notifying the community that preparation for removing hazardous waste from Zone A of the Pasco Landfill is starting. Cleanup activities are expected to take about 19 months to complete. The site is not accessible to the public, and many measures will be in place to ensure community safety.
