On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC), Arcadis U.S., Inc. (Arcadis) is providing this progress report to document activities performed to satisfy the requirements of Agreed Order No. 10629 (Agreed Order) associated with the former Chevron facility 96590 located at 232 East Woodin Avenue in Chelan, Washington (site).

Section VII D of the Agreed Order requires quarterly progress reports be submitted to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month following the reporting period. This report summarizes activities completed from April 1 through June 30, 2020.

## Description of Actions Taken to Comply with Agreed Order

- On May 29, 2020, Arcadis submitted the Draft Phase 5 Supplemental Remedial Investigation (SRI) Work Plan to Ecology for review.
- Ecology responded with comments regarding the Draft Phase 5 SRI Work Plan in an email dated June 1, 2020. Arcadis responded to comments on June 3, 2020, in an email.
- On June 17, 2020, Arcadis submitted the Final Phase 5 SRI Work Plan which incorporated Ecology's comments.
