



**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE  
(DNS)**

**Description of Proposal:** Ephrata Landfill Interim Remedial Action: Remove approximately 8,200 cubic yards of potentially contaminated soil from the Ephrata Landfill cleanup site and dispose in the Grant County Landfill.

**Proponent:** Grant County Public Works

**Location of Proposal:** Approximately 200 feet east of the old landfill entrance located at the NW corner of the property in SW¼, NW¼, S33, T21N, R26E

**Lead Agency:** Washington State Department of Ecology

The Department of Ecology has determined that the proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2) (c). This decision was made after review of the Environmental Checklist and other information on file. This information is available to the public on request.
