



## DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** Interim actions are proposed at the Peshastin/Dryden Elementary School. These interim actions will be conducted during the summer of 2008.

The interim remedial action cleanup plan includes capping of contaminated soil and managing the sites to minimize exposures to lead and arsenic until such actions are completed. To the extent possible, the clean up will conform to future school district facility plans.
