COMMENTS

The letter from October 1994 is from Ecology stating requirement for reporting at LUST sites. There is another letter talking about a closure of a 500-gallon waste oil UST in 1989. It was removed and four samples were taken and there was one heavy oil detect of 7900 ppm. Letter was very brief so not sure if anything was done about it. Report from Jan 1995 - PNE was hired to locate and decommission a possible 7 USTs. After tracing the vent lines and doing additional investigating three USTs were discovered. One was a 1500-gallon and one was a 1000 gallon. Initial sampling indicated the presence

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of TPH-D and TPH-HO. The USTs were removed and PCS was observed and excavated. There were soil borings taken around the USTs but no confirmation samples taken. While taking the first boring the third UST was discovered. The borings were only analyzed using a PID in the field. The third tank was a 10,000-gallon tank. An initial sample analyzed using EPA Method 3550/8015 detected mineral spirits at 67 ppm but did not detect jet fuel, gasoline, kerosene, diesel, or other (motor oil?). Sidewall samples were taken once the UST was removed and analyzed with WTPH-D. There were diesel and oil detections TPH-D (17-5300) TPH-HO 100-630. No further clean up was done at the site and report indicates the property changed ownership since they had been hired.

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
