The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed the above-referenced document, which was received in two parts, dated April 2005 and June 5, 2005. Alternative 2C is listed as the preferred cleanup action alternative in the above document. Ecology agrees with the selection of this alternative. As part of this alternative, Ecology supports the installation of vertical wells, as opposed to angled wells.

Per our phone conversation of April 6, 2006, it was decided that SAIC would be the lead in drafting the Cleanup Action Plan for the site contingent upon Ecology approval of the proposed schedule.
