Thank you for working with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on the Chevron 90619 cleanup site (Site). This letter provides written notification that the remedial actions required by Agreed Order No. DE 15742 have been satisfactorily completed and that no further remedial action is necessary to clean up contamination at the Site under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70A.305 RCW. This letter also describes the removal of the Site from Ecology's Hazardous Sites List. The Order became effective on July 6, 2018 and was amended on January 7, 2021.

**Satisfaction of Order**

Ecology has determined the requirements of the Order have been satisfied. Ecology made this determination pursuant to IX (Satisfaction of Order).

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The remedial actions required by the Order are specified in Section VII (Work to Be Performed). After inspecting the Site and reviewing the supporting documentation, Ecology has determined that the remedial actions required by the Order have been satisfactorily completed.

### **No Further Action Determination**

Ecology has determined that no further remedial action is necessary to clean up contamination at the Site under MTCA. Ecology has also determined that no post-cleanup controls or monitoring are necessary under MTCA.

### **Delisting of the Site**

Based on Ecology's determination that no further action is required, Ecology proposed removing the Site from the Hazardous Sites List (HSL). Ecology published notice of the proposal in the Site Register on December 3, 2020 and provided a 30-day public comment period, from December 4, 2020 to January 3, 2021. Two comments were received. After review and consideration of the comments, Ecology removed the Site from the HSL on January 4, 2021. The removal will be reflected in the next publication of the HSL in the Site Register.
