



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: An environmental cleanup of the Cream Wine site in the City of Sunnyside is proposed. The remedial action will include excavation of contaminated soils and disposal at an approved off-site facility. Clean soils will be brought in to fill and re-grade the site. Reagents will be injected into groundwater to breakdown a tetrachloroethylene (aka perchloroethylene or PCE) contamination plume.

Proponents: Washington Department of Ecology

Location of proposal, including street address if any: The property is located at the southeast corner of the intersection of E Lincoln Avenue and First Street at 111 East Lincoln Avenue, Sunnyside, Washington.

Lead agency: Washington Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c).
