incident Summary:

Responded to a 10 gallon food grade hydraulic oil spill at Ocean Gold Seafoods in Westport. Ocean Gold Seafood notified Ecology directly of the hydraulic oil spill. NRC was notified directly thereafter. A hydraulic hose broke on one of their 8 pumps (pump #8) used to maintain the plant, and run conveyor belts ect... Hydraulic oil impacted a drain with a sump that discharges to their process water system. As I understand, the oil was trapped in the sump (I assume plugging it) and oil/water discharged out to the waterway and not into their process water system. I notified ECY/WQ Aziz Mahar about this incident. The hydraulic pump was shut down. Due to tidal conditions the oil hugged the shoreline in front of the Ocean Gold facility. The oil was contained along the shore at the Ocean Gold facility and was boomed using absorbent boom. Absorbent pads were also used to recover the oil. Richard with the Port of Grays Harbor also responded before I arrived. At the time of the spill there was a significant amount of fish emulsion in the waterway. From my understanding it was due to the tuna vessels in port at this time of year. And on another note, there were was also a significant amount of sea lions congregating on float 15. Warning Letter issued December 31, 2016. Penalty matrix total was 6 points.

I notified ECY/WQ Aziz Mahar about this incident.
I notified ECY/WQ Marc Paifico regarding the fish emulsion and sea lions.
