PROGRESS REPORT NO. 3 – JANUARY 2017 FORMER AMERICAN LINEN SUPPLY CO. AGREED ORDER NO. DE 14302

Dear Ms. Cardona:

On behalf of BMR-Dexter LLC ("BMRD"), PES Environmental, Inc.("PES") is submitting this monthly progress report in accordance with the requirements of Agreed Order No. DE 14302 (the "AO") between the State of Washington Department of Ecology ("Ecology") and BMRD. Specifically, the progress report was prepared to fulfill the requirements of Sections VII.F and VII.G of the AO. This progress report provides information pertaining to work conducted during January 2018.

This progress report includes discussions of: (1) activities that took place during the reporting period, (2) deviations from approved work plans or other required tasks not already documented in project plans or reports, (3) deviations or anticipated problems in meeting the schedule or objectives set forth in the AO or approved work plans, (4) validated laboratory data received and data entered into Ecology's Environmental Information Management ("EIM") database during the reporting period, (5) work planned and anticipated deliverables for the next reporting period (i.e., February 2018), and (6) summaries of contacts with representatives of the local community, public interest groups, press, and federal, state, or tribal governments.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED DURING THE REPORTING PERIOD

During the reporting period, BMRD conducted the following work:

- Submitted the revised SEPA checklist to Ecology on January 2, 2018;
- Coordinated with Ecology throughout January regarding the planned public meeting for the Interim Action Work Plan ("IAWP") including facility location, public notice information, preliminary presentation graphics, and presentation outline and content;

- Submitted redline version of Section 10 of the IAWP and related figures to Ecology for review on January 4, 2018;
- Met with Ecology on January 5, 2018, to review final edits and questions regarding the IAWP;
- PES, on behalf of BMRD, requested an extension to the due date for the Agency Review Draft of the RI/FS Work Plan, consistent with Section VII of the Agreed Order. The proposed new due date was March 16, 2018. Ecology approved this extension via e-mail the same day;
- Provided addition information regarding the proposed IAWP injections to Mary Shaleen-Hansen in Ecology's UIC Program on January 5, 2018;
- Finalized the Public Review Draft of the IAWP and the IAWP SEPA checklist and submitted both to Ecology on January 10, 2018;
- Submitted Progress Report No. 2 to Ecology on January 16, 2018;
- Met with Ecology on January 19, 2018, to discuss data gaps to be addressed in the remedial investigation (RI), the outline of the RI and feasibility study (RI/FS) Work Plan, and begin coordination regarding the public review period and public meeting for the IAWP;

DEVIATIONS FROM REQUIRED TASKS NOT ALREADY REPORTED

No unreported deviations from required tasks occurred during the reporting period.

DEVIATIONS FROM THE SCHEDULE

Aside from the extension to the due date for the Agency Review Draft of the RI/FS Work Plan noted above, no other deviations were encountered during the reporting period, and there are no anticipated problems in meeting the schedule or objectives set forth in the AO.

VALIDATED DATA RECEIVED AND DATA ENTERED INTO EIM

The validated data collected data associated with the additional soil investigation conducted in late November and early December has been received. The data is being uploaded into the EIM database.

No other validated data were received, and no other data were entered into the EIM database during the reporting period.

WORK PLANNED AND ANTICIPATED DELIVERABLES DURING UPCOMING REPORTING PERIOD

Work planned during the February 2018 reporting period includes:

- Assist Ecology with preparation of documents and presentation materials needed for the planned public meeting for the IAWP scheduled for February 27, 2018;
- Continue preparation of the draft RI/FS Work Plan;
- Begin installation of IAWP injection and on-Property monitoring wells; and
- Upload the November/December validated the data associated with the additional investigation conducted in November/December data into the EIM database. Data and results will be presented in the forthcoming RI/FS work plan.

Deliverables anticipated to be submitted to Ecology during the February 2018 reporting period include:

• No formal deliverables are anticipated during February 2018.
