

## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

**Description of Proposal:** 

Teck American Incorporated is proposing to remove slagimpacted sediments from an area commonly referred to as Black Sand Beach (BSB). The proposal is a voluntary independent interim action that will include removal of approximately 5,000 cubic yards of slag-impacted sediment and placement of imported backfill for beach restoration. BSB is located along the Upper Columbia

River.
