Dear Mr. Reif:

Enclosed are documents which meet conditions 3 and 4 in Mr. Burkhalter's letter to Reynolds regarding the closure of the black mud surface impoundment. These are:

- (1) Certification by an independent professional engineer licensed in the State of Washington.
- (2) The Notice of Deed Restriction filed with the Cowlitz County Auditor.

In addition, Reynolds estimate of the quantity of black mud in the surface impoundment agrees favorably with the inventory figure in the closure plan on page I-3.

The exact point at which closure is considered complete is unclear to Reynolds. It would be desireable to discuss the transition between closure and post-closure so that we have a clear understanding of all requirements.

Commencing at the Northwest corner of said D.L.C., as marked by an iron pipe identified as Long Bell corner 303 and being a corner of the Reynolds Metals Company tract as recorded in Deed Volume 264, Page 539 (Fee No. 209738), thence South 02°15'37" West along said Reynolds Metals West line (S. 00°34' W. deed bearing) 110.19 feet; thence South 87°44'23" East 332.73 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence south 88°42'57" East a distance of 594.33 feet; thence South 68'09'00" East a distance of 177.28 feet; thence South 00°36'31" East a distance of 903.58 feet; thence South 00°06'16" West a distance of 693.36 feet; thence North 87°16'52" West a distance of 998.57 feet; thence North 35°44'24" West a distance of 72.46 feet; thence North 05'02'03" East a distance of 1264.52 feet; thence North 27°31'36" East a distance of 349.97 feet to the Point of Beginning.
