Ecology has determined that no further action is necessary (at the Initial Investigation stage) due to independent remediation.

Ecology received the following report:

The above report provides sufficient documentation that this cleanup was conducted to MTCA Method A cleanup levels for unrestricted land use. Richard Bazzell, Kitsap Public Health District, has recommended no further action at this site, and Ecology concurs. This cleanup meets the eligibility criteria and individual provisions for Model Remedy 1, as defined in Ecology <u>Publication No. 15-09-043</u>.
